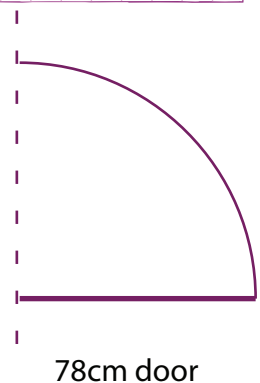


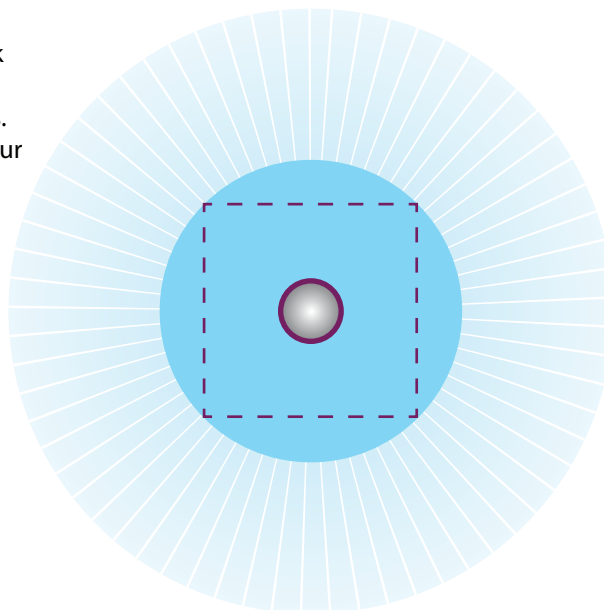
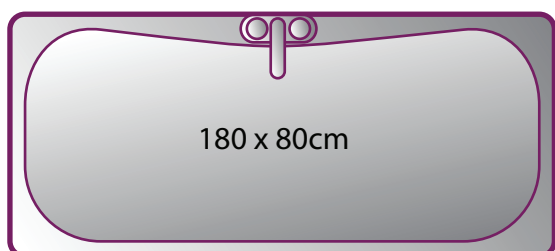
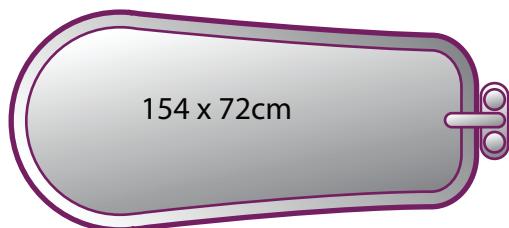
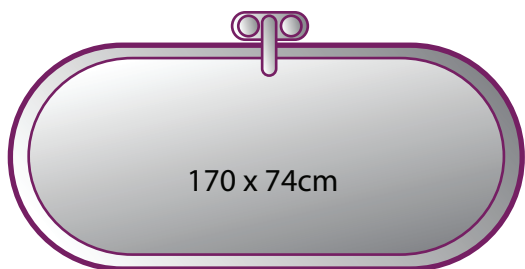
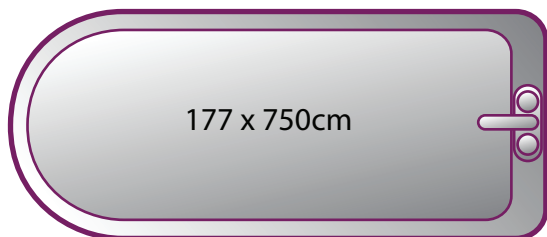
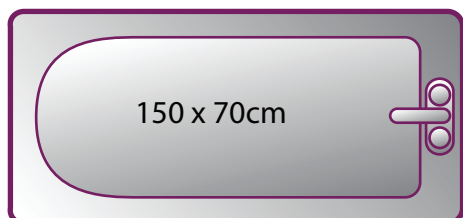
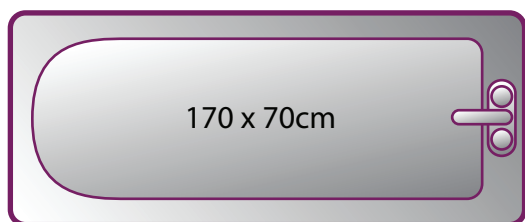
Grid scale matches the bathroom items on page two of the pdf.

1. Print out PDF page 1 and 2.
2. Draw a plan of your walls, door and window on the grid.
3. Check the website for design guidance.
4. Cut out the bathroom items you need from page 2.
5. Experiment with item positions for your wetroom design.
6. Add wetroom screens / doors / flippers to limit the showering area if required.
7. Find all the specialist wetroom products you need and place your order at DIYwetroom.com



The scale of these items matches the grid on page one of the pdf.
